DR. MICHAEL L. BROWN is an Old Testament scholar and Messianic Jewish Apologist who holds a Ph.D. in Near Eastern Languages from New York University. He is the author of twenty books, including a commentary on the book of Jeremiah and the highly-acclaimed five-volume series *Answering Jewish Objections to Jesus*. Brown serves as a visiting or adjunct professor at four leading seminaries, and his work has been featured in the *Charlotte Observer*, the *Washington Post*, and the *Baltimore Sun*.



DR. BART D. EHRMAN is the author of more than twenty books, including two *New York Times* best-sellers: *Misquoting Jesus* and *God's Problem: How the Bible Fails to Answer Our Most Important Question — Why We Suffer*. Ehrman is the James A. Gray Distinguished Professor of Religious Studies at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and is a leading authority on the New Testament and the history of early Christianity. His work has been featured in *Time*, the *New Yorker*, the *Washington Post*, and other print and electronic media.
